This document will be used as a live document as guidance changes, this will be version controlled and issued to members as required.

Appendix 1

Dunnikier Park Golf Club - Rules for our return to competition Golf - R&A & Congu

Rules and Golf Related Matters

Until further notice, the following provisions are considered acceptable on a temporary basis:

- **Forms of Play and Scoring**

- Qualifying Golf will be allowed. The first Qualifying Competition will be the Harper Trophy.
- Thursday Qualifying non-courtesy Rounds may be re-introduced once the scoring system has been proved. This also includes the non-courtesy Friday 9 Holes. Notice will be given when this is available.
- Where competitive stroke play is played, a method of scoring needs to be used that does not require any handling or exchanging of scorecards.
- The golf committee will allow methods of scoring in stroke play that do not strictly comply with Rule 3.3b, or do not comply with the normal methods used under Rule 3.3b. For example:
 - Electronic scoring should be used, preferably the Mobile Scoring app linked to the member through the **Howdidido™** Members hub.
 - In the event that this is not possible by a player, a scorecard for individuals / each group can be submitted, scorecards will be added to the V1 Score System by the committee after a period of card isolation.
 - One marker may mark up to 2 additional players on one card **providing Competition, Date, time, all names and handicaps** are clearly marked and **readable**.

- All names, handicaps and scores **must be clear and easy to read** and in accordance with A, B and C. Where C, the marker, enters his / her score on the left column (Markers Score) and players A and B are entered in the appropriate column.
 - Entered score cards which are difficult to read may be disqualified. Take care when completing a card.
 - At the end of the round the scorer can sign the card as the scorer and enter into the receptacle provided at the Pro-Shop / Starters.
- **Teeing Areas**
 - All golfers to keep 2 metres apart at teeing areas.
 - Golfers should not pick up tees / used tees that are not their own.
 - **Local Rule for bunkers – PREFERRED LIES**
 - The Golf Committee feels that the enjoyment of the game is being significantly affected by there being no rakes, therefore we have introduced **preferred lies** in bunkers (other than those marked GUR) and provide that a player **may mark, lift and place** a ball within the bunker **not further than 6 inches from the reference point and not nearer to the hole** than that point.
 - After play from a bunker, golfers are advised to smooth the sand as best as possible with foot / club.
 - This local rule does not preclude use of rules 19.3a or 19.3b where required.

**Scottish Golf Qualifying Competitions Guidelines for Golf Clubs updated 24th June*

- **Flagstick**
 - Golfers are required to keep 2 metres apart on the green. Leave the flagstick in the hole at all times and do not touch it. The continued use of the fitted 'lifting device' on each flagstick is recommended.
- **General**
 - All golfers to stay more than 2 metres apart when walking to the ball, searching for a ball and playing shots. Golfers are not to touch stray balls.
- **After the Round**
 - All golfers must be mindful that currently, social distancing is as important after a round as it is during the round, so when the round is over they must leave the course and the club / facility / area immediately so that there are no gatherings around the pro-shop / starters area / clubhouse area until notification is received from Government that it is deemed safe to do so.

Competitions

Weekly Competitions can be played in 3 ball, and where possible player scores to be entered on Howdidido™ Members hub. (This replicates the ‘Computer’ in the club!). If a scorecard is required, max 1 scorecard between 3. The nominated scorer keeps score for all 3 (or 2 or 1 if others use Electronic scoring). Card returned to Scorers box at end of round.

Competition results may be delayed by up to 3 days because of card isolation.

Results in 2 sections as usual – 0-12 and 13-28. 85% total pay-out from entry fee. (Trophies will still need to be engraved this year). No vouchers will be issued, winners will added to bar cards but can be added to pro- shop by request through the Secretary.

Entry fees will be deducted from golf members Club Bar Card, this will be carried out at point of entering on V1 app (This includes being entered when phoning Pro shop to be added). If you intend to withdraw, please **do not** enter the Competition. For weekly competitions the entry fee will be non-refundable.

If you do not cancel your slot, normal rules apply and a 2-match penalty will be imposed. Tee times are tight so please respect your fellow members and cancel if you can't play.

Reserve Lists

There will be no reserve lists on the V1 on line entry sheets. We have 200 gent's slots per week and members are encouraged to enter into a vacant space across the varied courtesy days and time bands. If a space does become available then that is filled on a first come first served basis via V1 or phoning the shop.
