**LOCKDOWN 2020 – VIRTUAL CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

**13<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> June 2020**

We will have a virtual CC for Gents Ladies and Juniors. And yes, as it is 'RANDOM', ***any entrant*** may end up as the virtual Club Champion 2020. In these times of uncertainty, who will be our virtual Gents, Ladies and Junior Club Champion? (There will be no A or B, just a Virtual Club Champion in each section!) So how will we run this? Members who wish to enter should submit £5 via BACS ( sort code 80 16 84, account No 00185295 or by cash in an envelope to 63 Glenbervie Road, Dunnikier Estate, Kirkcaldy, not later than Friday 12<sup>th</sup> June, include your Name on the BACS transfer or envelope. Gents and Ladies will submit a £5 entry fee, junior members can be entered for free by adding your name on the junior Facebook page or emailing [Dpgcjuniors@gmail.com](mailto:Dpgcjuniors@gmail.com). There will be 6 Prizes – Winner & Runner Up in each section.

There will be a 50-50 split between Winner & Runner Up prizes and the Junior Development programme. (i. e. if we have 100 paid entries in total - £250 will go to junior development and £250 will be split between the winners and runners up of the 3 sections )

Your name will be added to the Gents / Ladies / Junior 'Wheel of Names' for the First Round which will begin on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> June. (Depending on numbers, the Gents wheel may be doubled up names on each slot on W O N). A computerised Random Number Generator will be set to select Nett 'Scores' between 65 and 100. Once a score is selected, the wheel will be spun and the first 'scores' will be added to the Players Names. This will be the Players 1<sup>st</sup> Round Nett Score. All scores will be posted on Facebook / Website.

The following weekend on 20<sup>th</sup> June, the second Round will take place in the same way, and the two scores will be combined. This will generate a top 32 gents (assuming more than 32 take part) and a top 8 Ladies (assuming more than 8 take part). Depending on the number of Juniors taking part there will be a top 8 as well.

A 'Wheel of Names' Match Play will be Drawn on Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June and Posted online / Facebook.

From Monday 22<sup>nd</sup> June to Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June there will be a 'knockout' 'Matchplay' competition each night to take each section down to two finalists for Saturday 26<sup>th</sup> June. This will be 'played' by a computerised 'dice' set of 3 Die. Cast N° 1 will be player 1 'score' (from a potential 18) and cast N° 2 will be player 2 'score' from potential 18. The higher Number will win by the 'difference'. i.e. player 1 scores 11 player 2 scores 15 therefore player 2 wins (by 4 clear 'holes'). Etc.

The CC Tables will be updated each evening after the 'event' and will be posted online and on Facebook.

The Wheel and Random Numbers etc will be carried out by members of the Committee on specially arranged 'Zoom Club Championship' Meetings in order to ensure 'Fair Play'!

On Finals Day for the Last 2 in Each section, there will be 36 holes played randomly for the Gents and 18 for the Ladies using the randomiser Wheel – Scoring will be added to each hole for each player (either win, loss or half). Each players spin will be their virtual score at the hole. In the event of a tie after each competition, extra 'virtual holes' will be played until winner.

All winnings will be added to bar cards, the other 50% of entry fees will be funded to Junior Development.
