

Winter Competition 2021-22

From Wednesday 27th October, the Winter Competition will 'revert' to 3 scoring events per week to enter a score on ClubV1 / Howdidido™ -Wednesday, Saturday and Sunday. As in previous years, as the Saturday is the 'key' day, if the Saturday is lost due to course closure or less than 75% returned scores from signing in, this will result in the competition being nullified for that week, any scores entered on the Wednesday (or Sunday) will not count for the Winter Competition that week.

Scores will require to be entered on the Day of Play - you will be required to SIGN IN to the competition using the V1 app or by asking the starter to sign you in prior to entering your Score on ClubV1 / Howdidido™. (Scores entered will be assessed alongside BRS Bookings). Winter Competition scores will be NON-QUALIFYING.

We are encouraging **all players**, where practical, to enter their score on the Clubhouse computer and submit a correctly completed scorecard through the letterbox in the clubhouse. Incorrectly marked or not properly completed scorecards will be disqualified. If you do not submit a card, and enter a score that is a 'winning' score it must be **verifiable**. **Scoring – There is a maximum PLAYING HANDICAP OF 24 (Hi 21.6 off Silver tees) and an adjustment of 75% of Playing handicap will be applied across all players.**

Tee times should be booked in accordance with the FGT rules and through BRS. Tees are available to be booked 1 week in advance. In Play Preferred lies apply on the Fairway AND SEMI-ROUGH (lift clean and place).

In the Winter Competition Scores table, a winner will receive 5 points, runner up 4, third place 3 points and all other players 1 point. A 1st place will result in a 'shots' adjustment of -2 and runner up will be adjusted by -1. This will be manually adjusted on the table each week, and will be the player's responsibility to be aware of their shots reduction. The ClubV1 system will NOT reflect the local adjustments when entering scores, so player should be mindful of this when viewing the results online on ClubV1.

Entry fee for the Winter Competition will be £1, payable in cash to the starter, and players can only enter once per week. Scores entered on the computer will be the Gross scores, and the results will show in the Stableford format, there will be a fixed prize pay-out each week of £12.50 for 1st and £7.50 for runner up in each section which will be paid directly onto bar cards. The sections for the Winter Competition are now Scr-9 and 10 and over.

The weekly results will be posted on Facebook and will be available in the Gents section of the Competitions section on the Club Website, as will the table showing the cumulative results for players.
